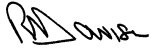
Important Information Regarding this Standards Update Notification

As part of this review it will be determined whether any additional information is needed or further evaluation and testing is required on product samples. See attached.
2. If the products currently listed will not be produced after the Effective Date for these new/revised requirements, please advise us of these products and their listings will be withdrawn on that date.
3. Currently listed products must be found in compliance with the new/revised requirements by the Effective Date or the authorization to apply the WHI Mark will be withdrawn.
4. All new products submitted will be evaluated to the new/revised requirements noted above unless you specifically request otherwise in writing. Please note that new product listings will be withdrawn on the Effective Date unless the product is found in compliance with the new/revised requirements.

Description of Changes

Impact Statement: A review of all Listing Reports is necessary to determine which products already comply with these new/revised requirements and which products will require re-evaluation and test.

NOTE: Effective immediately, this revised standard will be exclusively used for evaluation of new products unless the Applicant requests in writing that current requirements be used along with their understanding that their listings will be withdrawn on the **June 1, 2008** unless product is found to comply with the new/revised requirements.

Summary of Changes:

Paragraph 3.7 New requirements for cabinets with heat responsive links on self-closing doors identify compliance with UL33. A review of currently Listed products is not required as the new paragraph reflects existing evaluation practices.

Section 4 Revised requirements for all cabinets to clarify details of the Fire Endurance Test samples, equipment and method. A review of currently Listed products is not required as the revisions reflect existing evaluation practices.

Section 5 New requirements for all cabinets for evaluation of the containment sump with respect to leakage. A review of currently Listed products to the new section is required to determine compliance.

Section 6 New requirements for cabinets with self-closing door mechanisms to clarify details of the Cyclic Endurance Test. A review of currently Listed products is not required as the new section reflects existing evaluation practice.

Section 8 Revised requirements for all cabinets to reduce mark size for parts of the warning label, delete some label type specifications and clarify critical manufacturer information marks. A review of currently Listed products is not required based on a reduction of these requirements.

Section 5 A new requirement for all cabinets to have a sump to reduce leakage is required. All products currently listed must be reviewed to see if

- 1) a sump is included and;
- 2) does it meet the new requirements
